TSUNAMI ALERT CANCELLATION

A strong local earthquake occurred **offshore Negros Oriental** at **11:49AM, 06 February 2012** (Philippine Time), located at **9.97 °N, 123.14 °E** with depth of **10 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.9**. At 12:31PM, PHIVOLCS issued a bulletin with **Tsunami Alert Level 2** for areas along the coast of the Negros and Cebu Islands, stating that the concerned public is advised to **be on alert for unusual waves**.

PHIVOLCS has received some reports of unusual sea level changes within the projected arrival period of tsunami waves in the Negros and Cebu Islands coasts (11:49AM to 12:19PM of **06 February 2012** (Philippine Time)).

No further reports of unusual sea level changes were received after the two-hour extended observation period. **Hence, tsunami alerts for the Philippines are now CANCELLED.**

This will be the last bulletin issued for this event.
